A NOTE FROM Patricia & Jan



SYNOPSIS

The Path to Catherine is the true backstory of the teenage girl, Sophie, who will eventually become Catherine the Great, and the two women who shaped her.

Princess Sophie, a prospective wife for Peter, heir to the Russian Empire, finds herself pushed and pulled between the desires of her mother, Joanna, and Elizabeth, Empress of Russia. But her focus soon shifts from love to power, and she learns that power has a price; that price is family.

The Path to Catherine features a cast of three women and a sung-through score that has modern musical elements combining percussive grooves and soaring, emotional melodies that bring this untold, true, historic story to vivid life for a modern audience.

Jan Roper is a composer, music director, singer, keyboardist, and native Southern California girl. In her years of live stage experience, she has performed hundreds of high-profile gigs as singer and/or keyboard player at venues like the Hollywood Bowl and Greek Theater. She has been a featured singer at the Governor's Ball for the Oscars and the Emmys 6 times. In 2006 she launched her theater career with the full-scale production of her own original rock opera, Jerusalem A.D. Other original works: City of Light, was in the sheNYC Festival (2017), where it won Best Score. América Tropical, was the winner of the Raise Your Voice Award for diversity and inclusion in 2020 and recently had a staged reading produced by McCoy Rigby Entertainment at the La Mirada Theatre. And The Path to Catherine, was produced this year in Los Angeles with a 6-week run by Write Act Repertory. She also won the L.A. Scenie Award in the 2019-2020 season for Best Music Director.

Jan stays busy as a faculty teacher at AMDA College of the Performing Arts, and a vocal and music director in the local theater community of Los Angeles.


